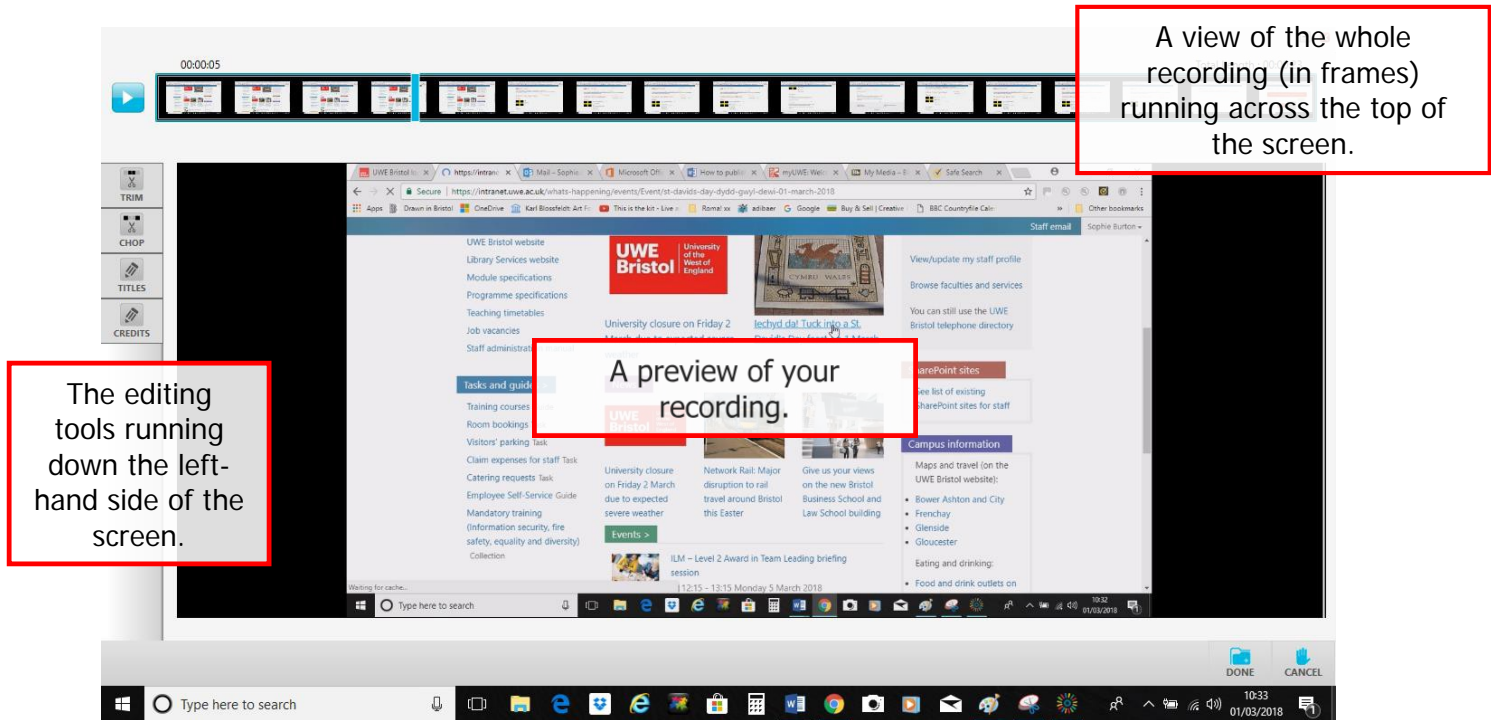


How to edit your Kaltura recording

The video editor



The editing tools

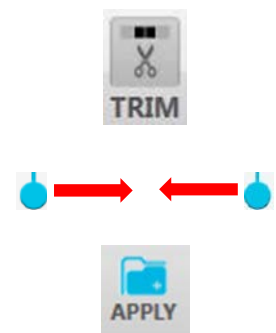
1 Trim

Trim footage from the beginning and end of the recording.

When you select the 'Trim' function, a blue marker appears at either end of the footage (frames) at the top of the screen. Click and drag to select the footage you want to remove.

Note:

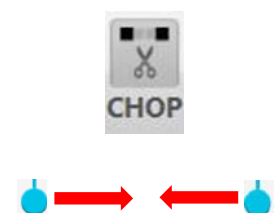
- Any footage that is greyed out will be removed.
- Make sure you click 'Apply' before moving on to another tool.



2 Chop

Remove unwanted sections in the middle of the recording.

When you select the 'Chop' function, the blue markers will appear at each end of the frames at the top of the screen. Click and drag to select the section of footage you want to remove.



- Any footage that is greyed out will be removed.
- Make sure you click 'Apply' before moving on to another tool.



3 How to make more than one 'chop'

To use the 'chop' function more than once, click 'Apply' after each 'chop'. Note that applying your changes is not permanent until you click 'Done'.

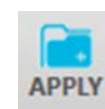
4 Titles

'Titles' enables you to add a title page to the beginning of the recording. Use the left and right scroll arrows to browse the templates.



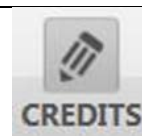
Note:

- Make sure you click 'Apply' before moving on to another tool.



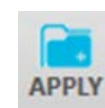
5 Credits

'Credits' enables you to add a credit page to the end of the recording.



Note:

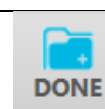
- If you have added a title page, the credits page will automatically use the same template.
- Make sure you click 'Apply' before moving on to another tool.



- 6 Preview your recording to make sure you are happy with the changes you have made (click on the play button located in the top left of the screen).

- 8 When you are happy with your recording click on 'Done' to make your changes permanent.
